National Board Certification is the highest credential in the teaching profession. Certification is achieved by meeting rigorous standards through intensive study, expert evaluation, self-assessment, and peer review. The National Board is an independent nonprofit group comprised mainly of teachers. Its mission is “to establish high and rigorous standards for what accomplished teachers should know and be able to do.” Since 1987 nearly 74,000 teachers have achieved National Board Certification.
