Student parking on school grounds is a privilege. To help ensure student safety in the parking lot and support the educational environment, all students must obtain a parking permit to park in Casa Grande's student lot. Parking permit applications are available in H5, the Student Services Office. Please read the following guidelines for student parking at Casa Grande:

- 1) Casa Grande parking permits must be affixed to bottom driver's side windshield.
- 2) Parking permits are transferable between vehicles in the same family, but not between students. **(All vehicles must be registered.)**
- 3) A parking permit does not guarantee a parking space. Parking is available on a first come, first-served basis.
- 4) Student parking is limited to the main student parking lots on Ely Blvd. and Juliet Dr.
  - a. Students may park only in the student parking stalls.
  - b. Students may not loiter in vehicles parked in student lots or in and around the student lots during breaks and lunch.
  - c. Students are subject to all traffic laws on campus. Students may be ticketed for parking in handicapped spaces and red and yellow loading zones.
  - d. Students may lose parking privileges for unsafe/reckless driving, excessive noise, or parking in non-student parking spaces.
- 5) Vehicles parked on campus are subject to search in compliance with CA Ed Code. Students cannot bring or store items prohibited on school grounds in vehicles.
- 6) Petaluma City Schools and Casa Grande High School are not responsible for damage or loss to the vehicle or personal property.
- 7) Students who park on campus without displaying a permit may be subject to disciplinary consequences which may include detention, loss of parking privilege on campus, or suspension.
